The Q-Codes are a classification of non-clinical items in General Practice / Family Medicine (GP/FM).

The Q-Codes, whose classification is complementary to ICPC-2, are part of the 3CGP project and are intended to retrieve the main organizational concepts in GP/FM.

Son un capítulo complementario a la CIAP-2, hacen parte del proyecto 3CGP (Core Content Classification in Primary Care / Clasificación del contenido esencial de la atención primaria), destinado a recuperar los principales conceptos organizacionales de la Medicina Familiar. El proyecto 3CGP combina la CIAP-2 con los Códigos Q para crear una nueva ontología con el propósito de mejorar la indexación de la literatura gris en medicina general y de familia.

Les Q-Codes tendent à représenter l'essentiel des concepts organisationnels de la Médecine de Famille. Les Q-codes forment un chapitre complémentaire à la Classification Internationale des Soins Primaires, deuxième édition (CISP-2). Ils font partie du projet 3CGP (Core Content Classification in Primary Care – Classification du Contenu Essentiel des Soins Primaires). 3CGP allie donc la CISP-2 et les Q-Codes à des fins d'indexation documentaire.
